WHEREAS, upon the petition of Robert O. Shumate, Jr., and Kimberly S. Shumate, a public hearing was held at 7:30 o'clock p.m., on the 23rd day of March, 1998, at the Yulee County Building, located at 70 Pages Dairy Road West, Yulee, Florida, pursuant to a notice duly published as provided by law for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners to close, vacate, and abandon the roadways or alleyways hereinafter described and to renounce and disclaim the right of the public and the county in and to said roadways and alleyways described as follows:

WHEREAS, no one appeared at said hearing to oppose said petition, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that said roadways or alleyways lie wholly without the corporate limits of any municipality and that this Board is authorized to close said roadways or alleyways by the authority stated in Section 336.09, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board has determined that it is in the best interest of Nassau County and the public that said roadways or alleyways be closed, vacated and abandoned and that the interest of Nassau County and the public be renounced and disclaimed therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 23rd day of March, 1998 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in a meeting duly assembled that said roadways or alleyways as hereinbefore described in the preamble hereto be, and the same is, hereby closed, vacated, and abandoned to the extent as if said roadways or alleyways had never been delineated on said plat.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the right and interest of Nassau County and the public in said roadways above described be, and the same are hereby renounced and disclaimed, and any easement heretofore owned, held, claimed or used by or on behalf of the public therein is hereby abrogated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board shall cause to be published, within thirty (30) days after the adoption of this Resolution, in one issue of the Nassau County Record, a notice of the adoption of this Resolution closing, vacating, and abandoning all of those certain roadways or alleyways as

hereinbefore described in the preamble hereto, and the renouncing and disclaiming of any right or interest of the county and the public in said roadways or alleyways.
