

RESOLUTION NO. 98-77

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE BE INSTALLED AT THE INTERSECTION OF C.R. 119 AND U.S. 301 IN BRYCEVILLE, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has been made aware of the need for the installation of a traffic control device at the intersection of C.R. 119 and U.S. 301 in Bryceville, Florida; and

WHEREAS, this section of highway is heavily congested; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, believes it is in the best interest of the public's safety that a traffic control device be installed at the intersection of C.R. 119 and U.S. 301 in Bryceville.


