A RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CERTIFYING THAT MONIES FROM THE EMS COUNTY GRANT AWARD WILL BE USED TO IMPROVE AND EXPAND THE COUNTY'S EXISTING PRE-HOSPITAL EMS SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners is responsible for the provision of pre-hospital Emergency Medical Service, and


WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners is committing to maintaining and improving Pre-hospital Emergency Medical Services to the citizens and residents of Nassau County, Florida and tht the grant monies will not be used to supplement existing County EMS Budget Allocations.

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners will use funds in the amount of \$14,615.98 to be received from the County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Award Application, to improve the existing quality of pre-hospital mortality and morbidity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners certifies that monies in the amount of \$14,615.98 will be used to expand the extent, size or number of existing pre-hospital EMS activities or services in Nassau County, Florida.


