**WHEREAS**, on September 28<sup>th</sup> , 1999 the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing to finalize the 1999/2000 Budget and to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes,

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1999, adopt the following millage rates individually for the fiscal year from October 1, 1999, to September 30, 2000:

TOTAL MILLAGE	7.0545

The total millage rates for the County including the dependent districts represents a 5.76% increase in property taxes over the rolled-back rate.
