RESOLUTION 99-98

WHEREAS the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners ceased its selfinsured worker's compensation program and purchased third party insurance effective October 1, 1994. However, the County is still liable for the open claims as of September 30, 1994.

WHEREAS there are only six open claims, a separate fund to account for the worker's compensation self-insurance program is not considered necessary. The open claims activity can be recorded in the applicable funds and departments for which the employees worked.

BE IT THEREFORE resolved by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida in regular session, duly assembled on the <u>26th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 1999 to close the Worker's Compensation Self-Insurance Fund, transferring asset and liability balances to applicable funds and to account for the open claims in the applicable funds/departments.
