**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF NASSAU COUNTY OPPOSING THE CLOSING OF THE S&G
PACKAGING PLANT IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, a total of 303 employees presently work at the S&G plant in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, 177 of those employees are Nassau County residents; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been made aware that the plant will be closing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is vitally concerned about the employees and their families as well as the economic impact to the entire county; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is desirous of protecting the employees and their families and maintaining a viable corporate economic partner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 12th day of January, 2000, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners opposes the closure of the S&G Packaging Plant in Nassau County, Florida.
2. The Board of County Commissioners requests an immediate meeting with the appropriate corporate representatives to review this matter prior to any final closure plan.
3. The Board of County Commissioners urges that every effort should be made for the benefit of the employees and their families.
4. The Board of County Commissioners encourages S&G Packaging to remain as a valuable corporate economic partner and member of the community.
