A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF JUNE 19-28, 2000, AS CODE ENFORCEMENT APPRECIATION WEEK.

WHEREAS, Code Enforcement Officers provide for the safety, health, and welfare of the citizens of Nassau County through the enforcement of building, zoning, housing, and other codes and ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Code Enforcement Officers are often not credited for the jobs that they do in saving lives in improving the quality of life; and

WHEREAS, every day, assisted by support and program staff, they attempt to provide quality customer service to the public for the betterment of the community; and

WHEREAS, too many times their efforts go unnoticed, even after code compliance has been accomplished, due to their efforts and expertise; and

WHEREAS, Code Enforcement Officers are dedicated, well trained, and highly responsible individuals who take their jobs seriously and are proud of their Department and the local government within which they serve; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Association of Code Enforcement (FACE) has declared the fourth week of June be set aside by local government to honor and recognize their Code Enforcement Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 12th day of June, 2000, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that the week of June 19 through 28, 2000, be proclaimed as:


