**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, HONORING BARBARA BARSH

WHEREAS, Barbara Barsh worked tirelessly to assist with the development and adoption of the Nassau County Comprehensive Plan, which was adopted in January, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Barbara Barsh, through her depth of knowledge and dedication, provided Nassau County with valuable resources through the Northeast Florida Regional Planning Council; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County has been notified of the retirement of Barbara Barsh.


