## **RESOLUTION 2000-161**

WHEREAS the 911 Operations and Maintenance Fund has received and will continue to receive 911 wireless communication fees in accordance with the 1999 Florida Legislature Wireless Emergency Communications Act, Florida Statutes 365.172-174. Fees were collected by the state from customers starting August 1, 1999 and the first distribution was received by Nassau County April 25, 2000. The below amount represents the distribution periods March and April 2000.

WHEREAS the wireless fees received shall be used solely to pay recurring and nonrecurring costs of providing 911 or E911 service, as provided by F.S. 365.173(2). Funds received will be transferred to the Sheriff who will maintain a separate accounting of revenues and expenditures associated with the wireless fees.

WHEREAS this revenue was not anticipated in the 1999/2000 budget year by the fund.
