

RESOLUTION 2000 - 19

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SETTING FORTH A POLICY FOR PROGRAMS AND SPEAKERS.

WHEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, by Motion, established a policy for programs and participation of staff as speakers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners' existing policy for programs and speakers is directly related to provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA); and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that the policy should be specifically set forth in a Resolution, and the existing policy should be modified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 14th day of February, 2000, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. All County programs shall only be offered at facilities that meet the requirements of the Florida Accessibility Code.
2. Programs are defined as those planned by or conducted by the County for members of the public.
3. County programs should be held at County facilities unless approved at a separate facility.
4. The approval for utilization of a non-County facility shall be by the County Coordinator in writing. The County Coordinator shall insure that the non-County facility meets or exceeds the Florida Accessibility Code, and, further, that the

County's designated expert has verified the non-County facility's compliance with the Florida Accessibility Code.

5. All notices and informational documents regarding County programs shall contain the necessary language pursuant to the ADA and be approved by the County Attorney and/or County Coordinator.

6. The County Coordinator shall insure that all County programs comply with the provisions of the ADA and the Florida Accessibility Code.

7. County programs shall include County sponsored programs as well. "County sponsored" shall mean that the County provides substantial funding for the program or is the actual sponsor providing staff and/or control of the function.

8. County personnel may, at the request of organizations and/or clubs, be a guest speaker at any facility as long as the general public is not invited to attend, if so, then that is considered a County program. If the organization or club speaking invitation is for the organization or club, County personnel may speak at any facility.

9. The County Coordinator shall be made aware of all speaking requests prior to the speaking engagement.

10. All facilities that have organizations or club meetings should strive to meet the Florida Accessibility Code and other ADA

requirements.
