

RESOLUTION 2000 - 30

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY DUE TO THE DRY WEATHER CONDITIONS AND THE DRAUGHT INDEX.

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida has issued Executive Order No. 2000-64; and

WHEREAS, said Order declares a danger of wildfires and gives the Division of Forestry operational authority; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief of Nassau County recommends that a State of Emergency be declared due to the drought conditions and the danger of wildfires.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2000, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Florida Statutes, Chapter 252, and Ordinance No. 2000 - 06, the Board declares an emergency effective this date, March 13, 2000.

2. This Resolution shall activate all applicable disaster emergency plans.

3. The provisions of Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2000-06 shall take effect immediately.

4. The County Coordinator shall notify all entities that sell fireworks of the prohibition.


5. The State of Emergency shall exist until midnight on March 20, 2000, and may be extended in seven (7) day increments, by Resolution executed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman.


