## RESOLUTION 2000 - 69

A RESOLUTION LIFTING THE BURN BAN ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON AMELIA-ISLAND, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners had previously issued a burn ban on April 10, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the burn ban was based upon a high fire index level having been existing in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the fire index on Amelia Island is now at an acceptable level; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Marshal has indicated that he would issue a permit for the utilization of fireworks for two (2) resorts on Amelia Island; and

WHEREAS, based upon the information regarding the fire index level and the Fire Marshal's recommendation, the burn ban may be lifted for Amelia Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 14<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2000, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The burn ban pursuant to Ordinance 2000-06 is hereby lifted on Amelia Island until further Resolution signed by the Chairman or the full Board of County Commissioners.

2. The lifting of the ban is to take place immediately upon its execution by the Chairman.


