A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE NASSAU COUNTY
LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Local Mitigation Strategy Taskforce was created in August 1998, with the responsibility of developing a Local Hazard Mitigation Strategy; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County initiated the Local Mitigation Strategy development by entering into a contract with the Florida State Department of Community Affairs Division of Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County LMS Taskforce has completed a Local Mitigation Strategy which has been reviewed by the Florida State Department of Community Affairs as meeting the criteria for such documents; and


WHEREAS, this Local Mitigation Strategy is intended to provide a strategy to mitigate dangers and costs associated with weather and man made hazards and to provide a priority for mitigation activities in the event of a hazardous events occurring in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy Taskforce accepted the Strategy and has recommended it for acceptance by the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 13th day of August, 2001, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:


1. That the Nassau County Local Mitigation Strategy concept is endorsed as the guide for Nassau County's hazard mitigation activities.
