WHEREAS, Chip Wood has retired as Executive Director.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 20th day of August, 2001 that:

2. Acknowledges his extraordinary contribution to the youth of the county through his involvement in youth activities for over twenty-five years.




