WHEREAS the 911 Operations & Maintenance Fund has received and will continue to receive 911 wireless communication fees in accordance with the 1999 Florida Legislature Wireless Emergency Communications Act, Florida Statutes 365.172-174.

WHEREAS the wireless fees received shall be used solely to pay recurring and non-recurring costs of providing 911 or E911 service, as provided by F.S. 365.173(2). Funds received will be transferred to the Sheriff who will maintain a separate accounting of revenues and expenditures associated with the wireless fees.

WHEREAS this revenue was not anticipated in the 2000/2001 budget year.
