A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUTURE MAINTENANCE AND ATTENDANT
COSTS OCCURRING AFTER COMPLETION OF THE EDTF PROJECT NO.
00/0145A

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners executed an agreement on February 12, 2001 between the State of Florida Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development (OTTED) and the county; and

WHEREAS, said agreement provides that the county would agree by Resolution to accept future maintenance and other attendant costs occurring after the completion of the project for the portion of the project on the county system; and

WHEREAS, the portion of the project on the county system will be the access road approximately 1,000 feet in length along with a 200 feet diameter cul de sac; and

WHEREAS, the County and Mulch Manufacturing, Inc., have entered into an agreement regarding the roadway and cul de sac.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED this 14th day of May, 2001, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:

1. The Board of County Commissioners shall accept future maintenance and other attendant costs occurring after the completion of the roadway and cul de sac.




