## **RESOLUTION 2002- 127**

WHEREAS the 911 Operations & Maintenance Fund has received and will continue to receive 911 wireless communication fees in accordance with the 1999 Florida Legislature Wireless Emergency Communications Act, Florida Statutes 365.172-174.
