ADOPTING LOCAL LHAP FOR
FY 2000-2001, FY 2001-2002, FY2002-2003

WHEREAS, the Florida Housing Finance Corporation and the Florida Statutes require an adopted Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP) prior to the receipt and distribution of State Housing Initiatives Partnership funds; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County SHIP Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP) for **FY 2000-2001, FY 2001-2002, FY2002-2003** adopted by the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners has been revised to include additional strategies to meet the affordable housing needs of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee has recommended that various strategies be revised; and

WHEREAS, the LHAP shall affect the distribution of SHIP funds available in each fiscal year and for each strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee has recommended that the Nassau County SHIP Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP) for FY 2000-2001, FY 2001-2002 and FY 2002-2003 be amended; and






