

**RESOLUTION 2003-126**

**WHEREAS** on September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2003 the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on the tentative budget and the proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes from the fiscal year from October 1, 2003 to September 30, 2004.

**WHEREAS**, on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2003 the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners held a public meeting to finalize the 2003/2004 Budget to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in special session duly assembled on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2003 hereby adopts the following millage rates individually for the fiscal year from October 1, 2003 to September 30, 2004:

The Fiscal Year 2003/2004 County Wide operating millage rate, excluding special districts is 7.6821 mills, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 6.9545 mills by 10.46%.

The Fiscal Year 2003/2004 Municipal Service Taxing Unit operating millage rate is .3224 mills, which is greater than the rolled back of .2994 mills by 7.68%.

The Fiscal Year 2003/2004 Nassau County and Recreation and Water Conservation and Control District 1 operating millage is 0 mills. There was no tax levied in Fiscal Year 2002/2003.


The Fiscal Year 2003/2004 Total County aggregate operating millage rate is 7.9156 mills, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 7.17 by 10.40%.
