

RESOLUTION 2003 - 32

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS DIRECTING THAT NO CONCURRENCY APPLICATIONS BE PROCESSED OR CERTIFICATES ISSUED FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 99-06, as amended, which adopted a concurrency management system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been made aware, by the Traffic Engineering Coordinator, of new data received from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) which may affect concurrency determinations; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Engineering Coordinator has indicated that a thorough review of the FDOT data is necessary, and that said review period will take thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Engineering Coordinator has indicated that the review period is necessary prior to reviewing any concurrency applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2003, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Traffic Engineering Coordinator shall, within thirty (30) days of the date of this Resolution, review the FDOT data and make a report to the Board as to any

amendments necessary to the Concurrency Management Ordinance.

2. Commencing today, and continuing for a period of thirty (30) days from today, no concurrency applications will be processed by the Traffic Engineering Coordinator, and all applicants shall be notified in writing.

3. Any application under review as of today shall have the review suspended during the same thirty (30) day period, and each applicant shall also be advised in writing by the Traffic Engineering Coordinator.

4. At the conclusion of the thirty (30) day period or earlier as recommended by the Traffic Engineering Coordinator to the Board of County Commissioners, applications shall be processed.

5. The Board of County Commissioners may extend the thirty (30) day period upon recommendation of the Traffic Engineering Coordinator at a regularly scheduled Board of County Commissioners meeting.


