MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

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THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this ______ day of ______, by and between the STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, hereinafter called the "DEPARTMENT" and the NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, hereinafter called the "AGENCY".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the DEPARTMENT is preparing to undertake a project which is known as the construction of a Bike Path on 14th Street from Amelia Island Parkway to Sadler Road in Nassau County, Florida, Financial Project ID: 212577-2-52-01, which will be of benefit to the AGENCY; and

WHEREAS, the Agency, by Resolution No. <u>2004–155</u>, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B", and made a part hereof, has authorized its officers to execute this Agreement on its behalf; and

WHEREAS, the project requires agreement by the AGENCY to maintain the section of the Bike Path on 14th Street from Amelia Island Parkway to Sadler Road in Nassau County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the parties agree:

1. The DEPARTMENT will undertake the project and obtain federal approval for participation.

2. Upon completion and acceptance the AGENCY will assume responsibility for maintenance.

3. If there is evidence of historical or archaeological resources that could be adversely impacted, the AGENCY agrees to maintain the resources in accordance with Cultural Resource Management Coordinator (CRMC) recommendations.

4. To the extent permitted by law, the AGENCY shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the DEPARTMENT and all its officers, agents, or employees from all suits, actions, claims, demands, liability of any nature whatsoever arising out of, because, or due to breach of this agreement by the AGENCY, its subcontractor, agents or employees, or due to any negligent act, or occurrence of omission of commission of the AGENCY, its subcontractors, agents or employees. Neither the AGENCY nor any of its agents will be liable under this section for damages arising out of injury or damages to persons or property directly caused or resulting from the sole negligence of the DEPARTMENT or any of its officers, agents, or employees. The parties agree that this clause shall not waive the provisions of Section 768.28, F. S. or any similar provision of law. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have set their hands and affixed their seals on the day and year first above written.
