

RESOLUTION 2005 - 120

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 4 THROUGH 10, 2005, AS NASSAU COUNTY CAREER AND VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTER APPRECIATION WEEK.

1. The week of September 4 through 10, 2005, is hereby proclaimed to be:



2. The Board also commends all Nassau County Career and Volunteer Fire Fighters for their efforts on behalf of MDA.


