

RESOLUTION 2006 - 79

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AUTHORIZING RING POWER TO RE-BUILD A COUNTY-OWNED D250E CATERPILLAR ARTICULATED DUMP.

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Director has notified the County Administrator that the D250E Caterpillar articulated dump located at the Landfill is out of service; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Director further advised that three (3) quotes were solicited from the following: Industrial Tractor, Nationwide Equipment, and Ring Power; but only Ring Power responded; and

WHEREAS, Ring Power initially quoted \$3,840.41 to repair the equipment, but a motor tear-down indicated the damage was more significant; and

WHEREAS, Ring Power advised that the engine could be repaired for \$10,848.32 or re-built for \$32,299.03; and

WHEREAS, the re-built engine would include a three (3) year/five hundred (500) hour warranty; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator advised that the equipment is crucial to the Landfill operation and must be returned to the Landfill as quickly as possible; and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator and the Solid Waste Director recommend that Ring Power re-build the engine as it will provide a warranty and extend the operational life of the unit by three (3) years; and


WHEREAS, the County is presently leasing a tractor from Industrial Tractor for \$8,000.00 per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 28th day of April, 2006, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners, based on the recommendation of the county Administrator, hereby declares an emergency regarding the D250E Caterpillar articulated dump.


2. The County Administrator shall notify Ring Power to proceed to re-build the D250E Caterpillar for the sum of \$32,292.03.


