

**RESOLUTION 2006 - 85**

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING MAY 7 THROUGH 13, 2006,  
AS "NATIONAL ARSON AWARENESS WEEK".

WHEREAS, wildfire arson is a serious crime that affects all people and can only be stopped when citizens realize the physical and emotional damage suffered by arson victims; and


WHEREAS, wildfire arson poses a serious threat to lives, property, and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the destruction associated with wildfire arson is more than any of all other causes associated with wildland fires.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 8<sup>th</sup> day May, 2006, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:

1. The week of May 7 through 13, 2006, shall be designated as *National Arson Awareness Week*. The theme of this year's Arson Awareness Week is "Wildfire Arson - Preparedness and Prevention".




