### RESOLUTION NO. 2007- 212

A RESOLUTION OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA ELECTING TO USE THE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS LEVIED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY; STATING A NEED FOR SUCH LEVY; PROVIDING FOR THE MAILING OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Nassau County, Florida (the "County") is contemplating the imposition of special assessments for the provision of fire services; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to use the uniform method for collecting non-ad valorem special assessments for the cost of providing fire services to property within the unincorporated area of the County as authorized by section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, as amended, because this method will allow such special assessments to be collected annually commencing in November 2008, in the same manner as provided for ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, the County held a duly advertised public hearing prior to the adoption of this Resolution, proof of publication of such hearing being attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida this  $10^{\rm th}$  day of December 2007, as follows:

1. Commencing with the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2008, and with the tax statement mailed for such Fiscal Year, the County intends to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem assessments authorized in Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, as amended, for collecting non-ad valorem assessments for the cost of providing fire services. Such non-ad valorem assessments shall be levied within the unincorporated area of the County. A legal description of such area subject to the assessment is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated by reference.

- 2. The County hereby determines that the levy of the assessments is needed to fund the cost of fire services within the unincorporated area of the County.
- 3. Upon adoption, the County Clerk is hereby directed to send a copy of this Resolution by United States mail to the Florida Department of Revenue, the Nassau County Tax Collector, and the Nassau County Property Appraiser by January 10, 2008.
- 4. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
