conduct of Nassau County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 13th day of August 2008 by the Board of

County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:

1. The Board does hereby respectfully request that the State of Florida and local law

enforcement, including the State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit and the

United States Attorney for the North District of Florida do aggressively act using all

resources at their disposal to enforce all laws which prohibit unlawful gambling

activities.
