

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-146**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING A SECOND EXTENSION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA DUE TO TROPICAL STORM FAY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 2008-143 on August 19, 2008 declaring a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to Tropical Storm Fay; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 2008-145 on August 25, 2008 authorizing an extension of the state of local emergency in Nassau County due to Tropical Storm Fay in order to address flooding issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners exercised its authority under Chapter 252.38(3), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 252.38(3)(5) provides that the duration of the state of emergency declared locally is seven (7) days; and

**WHEREAS**, the seven day increment may be extended by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida has found it necessary to authorize a second extension of the state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida due to Tropical Storm Fay.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September 2008 as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida does hereby grant a second extension of the State of Local Emergency for an additional seven day


period through September 9, 2008 due to on-going flooding conditions associated with Tropical Storm Fay in areas within the county.
