## RESOLUTION NO. 2008-158

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2008 the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, held a public hearing on the tentative budget and the proposed millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, for the fiscal year from October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009.

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2008 the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, held a public meeting to finalize the 2008-2009 Budget to adopt the millage rate pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, in Regular Session duly assembled on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2008, hereby adopts the following millage rates individually for the fiscal year from October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2009:

MUNICIPAL SERVICE TAXING UNIT	1.6694

The Fiscal Year 2008-2009 County Wide operating millage rate, excluding special districts is 5.5670 mills, which is less than the rolled back rate of 5.6431 mills by 1.35 percent.

The Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Municipal Service Taxing Unit operating millage rate is 1.6694 mills, which is less than the rolled back rate of 1.6998 mills by 1.79 percent.

The Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Nassau County Recreation and Water Conservation and Control District 1 operating millage is 0 mills. There was no tax levied in Fiscal Year 2007-2008.

The Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Total County Aggregate operating millage rate is 6.7913 mills, which is less than the rolled back rate of 6.8850 mills by 1.36 percent.
