**WHEREAS**, throughout her entire career, Joan G. Blanchard has always treated every citizen with respect;


**WHEREAS**, Joan G. Blanchard has announced her retirement as of February 1, 2008.



1. The Board publicly thanks and commends Joan G. Blanchard for her twelve years of outstanding and dedicated service to the citizens of Nassau County.
