for Museum and Library Services; and


WHEREAS, all the citizens of Nassau County are

she may pursue other endeavors.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 10th day of March, 2008 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida that:


