WHEREAS, Vickie B. Rhoden announced her retirement effective May 28, 2011; and


WHEREAS, Vickie B. Rhoden will be deeply missed by those who had the honor to work with her, as well as the citizens of Nassau County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 20th day of July, 2011, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:


1. The Board publicly commends Vickie B. Rhoden for her outstanding service and dedication to the citizens of Nassau County.

3. The Board, on behalf of all the citizens of Nassau County, extends their sincere appreciation to Vickie B. Rhoden for all she has done to make this a great County.




