

RESOLUTION NO. 2012- 03

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE ASSISTANCE OF THE FLORIDA ATTORNEY GENERAL IN BANNING THE USE, SALE OR POSSESSION OF NEWLY SYNTHESIZED HARMFUL DRUGS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is alarmed at reports of widespread sale and use of harmful synthetic drugs, sold openly in retail establishments throughout Florida; and

WHEREAS, local government is limited in its ability to respond to this startling hazardous risk to the health, safety and welfare of our citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statutes Sections 893.035 - 893.0356, the Attorney General of the State of Florida has extraordinary powers to, by rule, implement statewide, consistent, expedient, and enforceable prohibitions on the sale, use and possession of these harmful drugs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, deems it necessary and desirable, in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare to respectfully request that the Attorney General implement measures to ban the use, sale or possession of newly synthesized harmful drugs.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Honorable Pam Bondi, Attorney General of the State of Florida.


