**WHEREAS**, Nassau County has many high-quality teaching professionals in traditional public schools and nonpublic schools who are committed to educating our children; and


**WHEREAS**, School Choice Week is celebrated across the county by millions of students, parents, educators, schools and organizations to raise awareness for effective educational options.




