

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016- 13A**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN OPPOSITION TO PROPOSED LEGISLATION THAT WOULD AMEND SECTION 125.0104, FLORIDA STATUTES, AS IT WOULD HAVE A NEGATIVE IMPACT ON THE TOURISM INDUSTRY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA AND ACROSS THE ENTIRE STATE OF FLORIDA.**

**WHEREAS**, a bill proposed by the Florida House of Representatives Finance and Tax Committee would amend s. 125.0104, Florida Statutes, and the amendments adversely impact the Tourist Industry in Nassau County, Florida;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed bill would greatly diminish local Home Rule as presently provided in s. 125.0104, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, believes there is no necessity to amend s. 125.0104, Florida Statutes; and


**WHEREAS**, there has never been an audit issue nor any allegation of financial impropriety regarding the Tourist Development Council in Nassau County since its inception in 1991.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida that:


1. The Board opposes any proposed legislation that would amend s. 125.0104, Florida Statutes.
