WHEREAS, Charlotte Young announced her retirement effective May 27, 2016; and


WHEREAS, Nassau County has truly benefitted from her service, work effort, good nature and compassion and for her unequalled ability to always "do it right".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 18th day of May, 2016, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida as follows:


1. The Board publicly commends Charlotte Young for her outstanding service and dedication to the citizens of Nassau County.






