

RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 77

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES, BUSINESSES, NOT FOR PROFITS AND INDIVIDUALS FOR THE ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT RENDERED DURING A WILDFIRE THAT OCCURRED IN BRYCEVILLE, NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA ON MARCH 22, 2017.

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2017, a fire caused by an illegal yard burn broke out in Bryceville, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the residents living in the area of County Road 119, County Road 121, and Countryside Acres subdivision were evacuated from their homes; and

WHEREAS, the wildfire consumed almost 700 acres of woodlands; two homes were destroyed, eight homes were damaged and at least nineteen outlying buildings such as sheds and barns were impacted; and

WHEREAS, the wildfire was the largest to impact Nassau County since 1998; and

WHEREAS, state agencies from both Florida and Georgia provided assistance; and

WHEREAS, nearly 200 first responders from a number of governmental and volunteer agencies lent their assistance in battling the blaze, thereby minimizing property loss and preventing human loss; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is grateful to all those who assisted in this tragedy.




