

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-102

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING A BURN BAN FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF NASSAU COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief, based upon current conditions and consultation with the Florida Forest Service, has recommended to the County Manager that the Board ban outdoor burning; and

WHEREAS, all outdoor burning shall be prohibited except pursuant to permits issued by the Florida Forest Service. The outdoor burn ban would not pertain to cooking on attended and monitored barbeque equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has declared the existence of a burn ban within the meaning of Section 590, Florida Statutes, for a duration commencing on May 24, 2019 and continuing until lifted by the Board of County Commissioners upon recommendation of the Nassau County Fire Chief.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 24th day of May, 2019, that:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, does hereby declare that conditions exist to declare a burn ban for a period commencing May 24, 2019 and continuing until lifted by the Board of County Commissioners upon recommendation of the Nassau County Fire Chief.
2. Said burn ban is to prohibit all outdoor burning, except pursuant to permits issued by the Florida Forest Service.


3. The appropriate media be notified of the burn ban as well as municipalities, Sheriff's Department and Florida Forest Service.
