## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-126**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE NASSAU COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCLAIMING NASSAU COUNTY'S INTENTION TO SUBMIT PRACTICES TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE 2019 HEALTHY WEIGHT COMMUNITY CHAMPION RECOGNITION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, obesity is a medical condition in which excess body fat has accumulated to an extent that it may have a negative effect on health; and

WHEREAS, according to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, 39.8% of adults

and 18.5% of children in the United States are considered obese; and

WHEREAS, obesity increases the risk of many serious health conditions including heart

disease, stroke, high blood pressure, type 2 diabetes, and cancer;

WHEREAS, 10.5% of adults currently have obesity related diabetes, 34.6% of adults

currently have obesity related hypertension, and nearly 1.5 million currently have obesity related

heart disease; and

WHEREAS, the current estimated annual cost to the health care industry for obesity related illnesses is between \$147 billion and \$210 billion per year; and

WHEREAS, 2016 statistics revealed that 63.2% of adults in Florida are currently overweight or obese; and

WHEREAS, 2016 statistics also revealed that in Nassau County, 66.1% of adults are obese; that's 3% higher than the State average!

WHEREAS, because of this, the Florida Department of Health is working to address obesity throughout the State and is recognizing individual counties on their efforts to create healthier communities; and WHEREAS, Florida's county and municipal governments play an important role in decreasing the prevalence of unhealthy weight in their jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County has implemented policies, plans, and programs that increase access to healthy food and encourage physical activity; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County intends to submit its best practices to the Florida

Department of Health for the 2019 Healthy Weight Community Champion Recognition Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 12<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2019, that:

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners is concerned about the impact obesity is having on the community.
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners has implemented plans, policies and programs to make a difference in the health of the community.
- 3. The Board of County Commissioners intends to submit practices to the Florida Department of Health for the 2019 Healthy Weight Community Champion Recognition Program.
