RESOLUTION FOR THE TERMINATION OF THE
STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY**

Resolution No. 2019-136

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 2019-135 on August 31, 2019 declaring a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to Hurricane Dorian; and

WHEREAS, based upon current conditions, the Nassau County Emergency Management and Sheriff has recommended to the County Manager and Board of County Commissioners that the state of local emergency previously established on August 31, 2019, be terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 5th day of September, 2019, that:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as of 0800 this day, does hereby rescind Resolution 2019-135 and terminates the previously declared state of local emergency for Nassau County, Florida.
