## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA DUE TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution No. 20-35 on March 18, 2020 declaring a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to COVID-19 and adopted Resolution No. 20-77 on March 25, 2020, Resolution No. 20-78 on April 1, 2020, Resolution No. 20-79 on April 8, 2020, Resolution 20-86 on April 15, 2020, Resolution 20-88 on April 22, 2020, Resolution 20-91 on April 29, 2020, Resolution 20-93 on May 6, 2020, Resolution 20-99 on May 13, 2020, Resolution 2020-100 on May 20, 2020, Resolution 2020-101 on May 27, 2020, Resolution 2020-103 on June 3, 2020 and Resolution 2020-106 on June 10, 2020 each extending the state of local emergency by seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners exercised its authority under Chapter 252.38(3), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 252.38(3)(5) provides that the duration of the state of emergency declared locally is seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the seven (7) day increment may be extended by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, as a result of COVID-19, the County continues to address situations within the County, and there exists a need to extend this local State of Emergency to facilitate measures to protect citizens, visitors and property.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 17th day of June, 2020 as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida does hereby extend the State of Local Emergency for an additional seven-day period through June 24, 2020 due to on-going situations associated with COVID-19 in areas within the county.
