WHEREAS, public health officials work tirelessly to keep citizens safe and healthy, often putting their own health at risk; and



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 18th day of November, 2020 that:


1. The Board recognizes the tremendous impact public health workers have on our citizens and environment.


