A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

**DUE TO COVID-19** 

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida adopted Resolution

No. 20-35 on March 18, 2020 declaring a state of local emergency in Nassau County, Florida, due to

COVID-19 and adopted Resolution No. 20-77 on March 25, 2020 and Resolution No. 20-78 on April 1,

2020 each extending the state of local emergency by seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners exercised its authority under Chapter

252.38(3), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 252.38(3)(5) provides that the duration of the state of emergency declared

locally is seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the seven (7) day increment may be extended by a majority vote of the Board of

County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, as a result of COVID-19, the County continues to address situations within the

County, and there exists a need to extend this local State of Emergency to facilitate measures to protect

citizens, visitors and property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau

County, Florida, this 8th day of April, 2020 as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida does hereby extend the State of

Local Emergency for an additional seven-day period through April 15, 2020 due to on-going situations

associated with COVID-19 in areas within the county.
