RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 87

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO AMEND THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT), SPECIFICALLY TITLE VI-CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND, TO REDUCE REQUIRMENTS FOR LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT FROM POPULATIONS THAT EXCEED 500,000 TO POPULATIONS THAT EXCEED 500,000.

WHEREAS, Congress approved the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security

Act on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Title VI-Coronavirus Relief Fund defines units of local government as those with a populations exceeding 500,000; and

WHEREAS, communities with populations under 500,000 have also been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and are in need of emergency assistance for individuals, families, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, Nassau County, Florida, is urging Congress to amend the definition of unit of local government, to be defined as "a county, municipality, township, village, parish, borough, or other unit of general government below the State level with a population that exceeds 50,000".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau

County, Florida, this <u>15th</u> day of <u>April</u>, 2020 that:

The Board hereby requests the United States Congress to amend the definition
of unit of local government, to be defined as "a county, municipality,
township, village, parish, borough, or other unit of general government
below the State level with a population that exceeds 50,000".
