

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021- 003**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA RESTRICTING DRIVING AND PARKING IN AREAS LOCATED DIRECTLY IN FRONT OF THE PETERS POINT PARK AND BURNEY PARK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2020-31, was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on October 12, 2020, which addressed driving and parking in the unincorporated areas of the beaches of Nassau County; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2020-31, Section 1 (2)(f) was amended on January 11, 2021, to state: “Annually, the Board of County Commissioners may, at the recommendation of the County Manager, restrict driving and parking, based on factors determined by the County Manager in areas located directly in front of the Peters Point Park and Burney Park. The factors and restrictions shall be set forth in a resolution to be considered by the Board of County Commissioners at a publicly noticed meeting.”; and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners acknowledges that these restrictions are necessary to ensure the safety and viability of beach uses for the citizens of Nassau County and it is in the best interests of Nassau County residents to restrict driving and parking in areas located directly in front of the Peters Point Park and Burney Park.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, that:

1. Parking and driving shall be restricted in the area fronting Peters Point Park as depicted on Exhibit “A” attached hereto. There shall be no parking in the area depicted on Exhibit “A” and the County Manager shall provide appropriate markings, signs, cones or other indications to mark the no parking area.
2. The County Manager shall utilize designated driving lanes within the restricted parking area indicated on Exhibit “A”. Driving shall only occur within the designated driving lanes.
3. There shall be no parking or driving within the area depicted on Exhibit “B” attached hereto.

4. The County Manager shall utilize appropriate markings, signage, cones or other indications to mark the no parking/driving area depicted on Exhibit "B".
5. This resolution shall be effective upon execution by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners.
6. Parking within the areas depicted on Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" shall be considered a violation and subject the driver/owner to a revocation of the permit for vehicular access on the beach. The revocation shall result in the immediate removal of the vehicle. Failure to remove the vehicle shall be considered a trespass and subject the driver/owner to a second-degree misdemeanor and towing of the vehicle.
7. Driving outside the designated driving lanes in the areas depicted on Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" shall be considered a violation and subject the driver/owner to a revocation of the permit for vehicular access on the beach. The revocation shall result in the immediate removal of the vehicle. Failure to remove the vehicle shall be considered a trespass and subject the driver/owner to a second-degree misdemeanor and towing of the vehicle.



Beach Driving Limited to Nassau County Residents Only

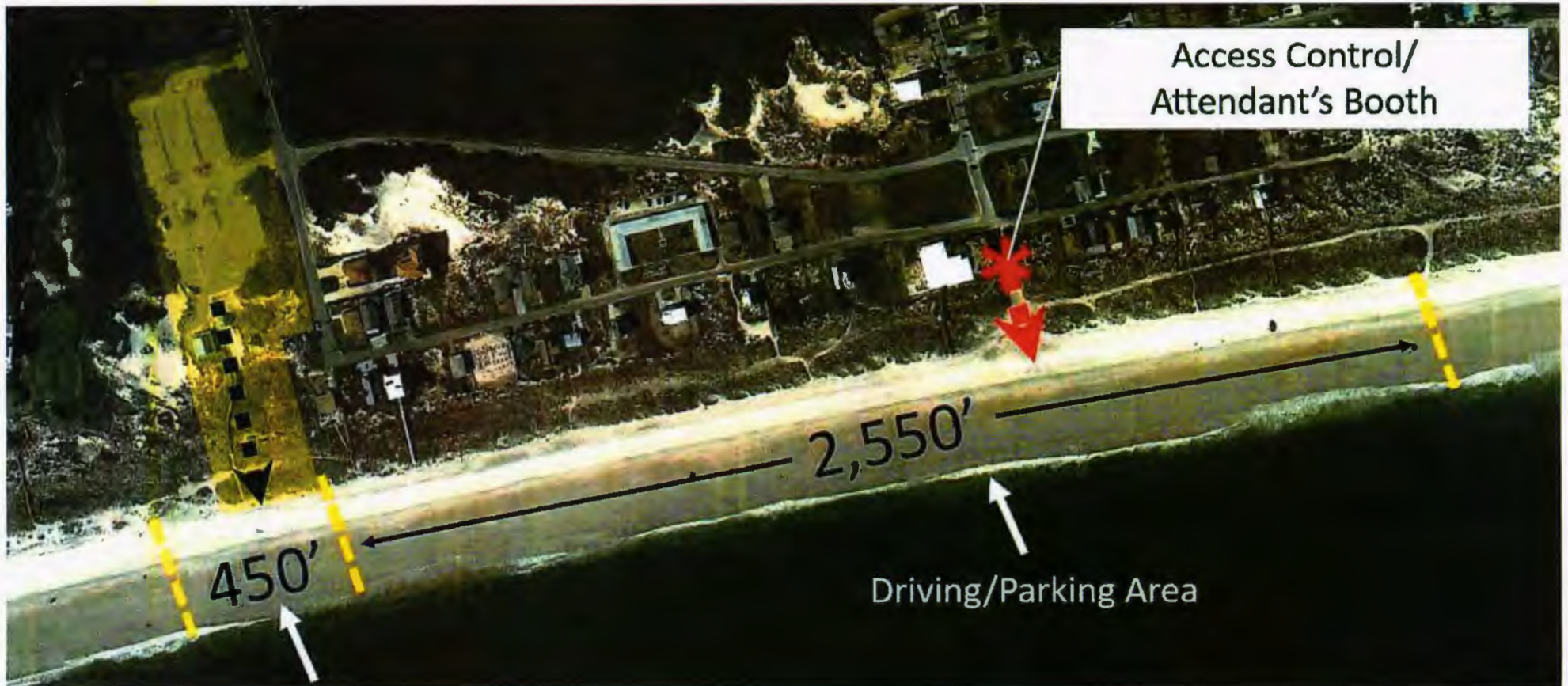
