**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
EXTENDING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA  
DUE TO COVID-19**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners exercised its authority under Chapter 252.38(3), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 252.38(3)(5) provides that the duration of the state of emergency declared locally is seven (7) days; and


**WHEREAS**, the seven (7) day increment may be extended by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of COVID-19, the County continues to address situations within the County, and there exists a need to extend this local State of Emergency to facilitate measures to protect citizens, visitors and property.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2021 as follows:

The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida does hereby extend the State of Local Emergency for an additional seven-day period from March 15, 2021 through March 22, 2021 due to on-going situations associated with COVID-19 in areas within the county.




