WHEREAS, George Aviles, Jr., in all his endeavors, has reflected great credit upon the County; and


WHEREAS, George Aviles, Jr., announced his retirement effective January 3, 2022; and

by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that:


1. The Board publicly commends George Aviles, Jr. for his outstanding service and dedication to Nassau County.


