

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-028

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE AMELIA ISLAND TREE
COMMISSION (NC-AITC).**

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Section 37.02 of the Land Development Code which is the Unincorporated Amelia Island Tree Protection and Replacement; and

WHEREAS, Section 37.02 requires the creation of a citizen advisory committee known as the Nassau County - Amelia Island Tree Commission (NC-AITC); and

WHEREAS, the NC-AITC should include, to the extent practicable, the following voting members appointed by the Board of County Commissioners: (1) a County planning and zoning board representative; (2) a Florida licensed landscape architect; (3) an International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) certified county arborist (county employee or contractor); and (4) two lay citizens who must be residents of the unincorporated area of Amelia Island; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has nominated five (5) members to the NC-AITC in order to assist the County in administering the Unincorporated Amelia Island Tree Protection and Replacement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 28th day of March, 2022, as follows:

1. The following individuals are appointed to the Amelia Island Tree Commission (NC-AITC) for the term indicated:




