

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-033**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF APRIL 10 – APRIL 16, 2022, AS NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.**

**WHEREAS**, National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week has been observed in the United States since 1981; and

**WHEREAS**, this week is designated for citizens to thank public safety professionals who respond to emergency calls and dispatch emergency professionals and equipment during times of crisis. Americans can show gratitude to 9-1-1 dispatchers, radio and emergency phone operators and technicians, communications center personnel, and other public telecommunications staff across the country who work tirelessly, often behind the scenes, to assist during emergencies: and

**WHEREAS**, emergencies can sporadically occur, and often require fire rescue, emergency medical services, and law enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of firefighters, paramedics and law enforcement is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Emergency Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators of Nassau County have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and


**WHEREAS**, the services of Public Safety Emergency Telecommunicators is a “silent service” and their duties are seldom observed by the public; and

**WHEREAS**, each Public Safety Emergency Telecommunicator has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year.




