A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA PROCLAIMING MAY 1 – 7, 2022, AS NATIONAL TRAVEL AND TOURISM WEEK

- WHEREAS, travel has a positive effect on Nassau County, the state of Florida and the nation's economic prosperity and brand image, it also impacts business productivity and individual travelers' well-being; and
- WHEREAS, travel to and within Nassau County provides significant economic benefits for our destination, with the hospitality industry creating a \$1 billion positive economic impact on Nassau County; and
- WHEREAS, Nassau County created the Amelia Island Tourist Development Council (AITDC) in 1988 which oversees the development and marketing of Amelia Island as a world-class tourism destination; and
- **WHEREAS**, tourism is among the largest private-sector employer in Nassau County, supporting over 30% of county employment; and
- **WHEREAS**, travelers' spending directly generates 32.9% of all local and state taxes paid in Nassau County as well as 25% of all ad valorem taxes paid in Nassau County;
- WHEREAS, funds generated from Tourist Development Taxes are used to support local programs such as Dickens on Centre, Restaurant Week and Artrageous ArtWalk; and
- **WHEREAS**, tourism-related business generated 28% of sales taxes in Nassau County in 2021 with over 687,400 overnight visitors to Amelia Island in 2021; and
- WHEREAS, the Amelia Island Tourist Development Council has increased the positive economic impact to Nassau County over 154% in the last 20 years; and
- WHEREAS, leisure and business travel spurs countless benefit to travelers' health and wellness, creativity, cultural awareness, education, happiness, productivity and relationships; and
- WHEREAS, travel is a pillar of economic growth, creating jobs at a faster rate than other sectors.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida this 25th day of April, 2022, that:
 - 1. The Board hereby proclaims the week of May 1-7, 2022 as National Travel and Tourism Week in Nassau County, Florida.
