**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF APRIL 9 – APRIL 15, 2023, AS NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.**

**WHEREAS**, National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week has been observed in the United States since 1981; and

**WHEREAS**, the second full week in April has been declared as “National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week” by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America;

**WHEREAS**, emergencies can occur at any time that require police, fire, or emergency medical services; and

**WHEREAS**, when an emergency occurs, prompt response of law enforcement, fire services and ambulance service is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

**WHEREAS**, the safety of our deputies, police officers, firefighters, and emergency medical personnel are dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained and relayed from citizens who use the 9-1-1- system; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Safety Telecommunicators of Nassau County have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and




